Camp Geronimo is a day camp for children with disabilities ranging in age from 6-12 where we provide animal assisted activities in addition to traditional fun camp activities. The Barn is fully wheelchair accessible as we accept campers with many different dx. Our camp is run by a PT who manages all the children's behaviors and each camper has their own counselor. Children who are very medically fragile come with their own homecare nurse who is responsible for their care. The camp day runs from 8:30 AM to 3 PM and the pay is \$25/hour. - RN degree, licensed in the State of Pennsylvania;
- Flexible-able to adapt to providing care in different environments.
- Confidence in nursing skills;
- Strong assessment skills;
- Prior experience with children (does not have to be in a medical capacity);
- Desire to be a team player;
- Have a genuine interest in working with and concern for children with special needs;
- Ability to interact with boys and girls ages 6-12 with varying ability levels
